

# BREAST SCREENING GUIDELINES OF PROFESSIONAL SOCIETIES IN THE US\*



Professional Society	Screening Age	Frequency
US Preventive Services Task Forces (USPSTF)	40 – 49	-Shared decision of whether to screen
	50 – 74	-Every 2 years (for average risk)
American Cancer Society (ACS)	45 – 55	-Annually
	55 – until life expectancy < 10 yrs.	-Every 2 years
American College of Radiology (ACR)	40 – until life expectancy < 5-7 yrs.	Annually
Society of Breast Imaging (SBI)	40 – until life expectancy < 5-7 yrs.	Annually
National Comprehensive Cancer Network (NCCN)	40 – until life expectancy < 10 yrs.	Annually
American College of Ob/gyns (ACOG)	40 – 49	-Shared decision of whether to screen
	50 – 74	-Shared decision: Annual or every 2 years
