## **WISDOM Residential History Questionnaire Instructions**

The WISDOM Study team is investigating how environmental exposures at home might affect a woman's risk of developing breast cancer, which is not well understood.

## Instructions for filling out the questionnaire

- This questionnaire will ask you to provide the addresses of the places you lived in the past. It will also ask about the addresses of the places where your mother lived when she was pregnant with you. Information about where your mother lived is important because some research suggests that exposures in utero can affect future breast cancer risk.
- The questionnaire will ask for your home address and how long you lived there.
- If you lived on a **United States Department of Defense (DoD)** base, locally or internationally, please include this address.
- Depending on your residential history, this questionnaire can take between **15 to 30** minutes to complete.
- Your answers will save automatically. You can complete this questionnaire in multiple sittings and come back to it at any time.
- Google Maps is available to help you search for your residential address. This may provide Google with your address information. You do not need to provide any confidential or private information.

## Tips for recalling your residential history

- We understand that it may be difficult to recall all the places you lived in the past.
- You may find it helpful to gather your residential information before starting the questionnaire. Consider looking at past bills or tax documents and have conversations with family members and friends who have known you for many years.
- It is okay to have "gaps" in your residential history. This is common for participants who have moved a lot or have trouble remembering.
- If you can't remember the full address, it's okay to provide partial information such as street name, cross streets, neighborhood, or a nearby landmark.
